Proposal - Mabe Parish Neighbourhood Development Plan

Details – Mabe Parish Council has submitted its proposed Neighbourhood Development Plan to Cornwall Council for public consultation and independent examination. The plan area covers the parishes of Mabe. The Neighbourhood Development Plan includes policies on housing, local green spaces, character, community facilities, transport, economy, parking and sustainability. Once made, these policies will be used to determine planning applications locally along with the Cornwall Local Plan.

Consultation on the submission (Regulation 16) version of the Neighbourhood Development Plan is taking place from Wednesday 30 November 2022 to Tuesday 17 January 2023 midnight. All representations received from this consultation will be made available to an independent examiner, appointed to examine the Neighbourhood Development Plan.
